Smoked Salmon Competition

September 22nd, 2012

Welcome to the 1st Annual Salmon Tales "Smoked Salmon Derby" where the title "Best Smoked Salmon in the Pacific Northwest" will be bestowed!

In the "Professional Division" competitors are required to provide 1 whole filet (either smoked whole or in sections) for the judging panel. This sample will first be judged on appearance, bouquet and presentation and then sampled by the judges who will score the entry for texture, color and flavor.

Each competitor will also provide a staffed booth offering approximately 1 oz samples to public participants who have purchased "Tasting Cards" (1 sample per card). Competitors will receive 50 cents for each tasting card sold to compensate for sampling product. Competitors are encouraged to improve the presentation of their sample by adding a side item (cracker/bread/?) which may make the difference in the "Popular Vote" award given as a result of the tabulation of Tasting Card Votes. Competitors can sell any smoked salmon or related products from their booth during the event.

The winner of the judged event will receive a handsome plaque proclaiming their product the "Best Smoked Salmon in the Pacific Northwest. 2nd & 3rd place entries will receive certificates. The winner of the "Popular Vote" will also receive a handsome plaque.

In the "Amateur Division" competitors are required to provide 1 whole filet (either smoked whole or in sections) for the judging panel. This sample will first be judged on appearance, bouquet and presentation and then sampled by the judges who will score the entry for texture, color and flavor. Winner of this division will receive a handsome plaque proclaiming them the "Best Home Smoker".
